

Program Management Analyst / Acquisition Specialist

Government contractor has immediate openings for 3-4 mid-level candidates to provide acquisition and program management support for leading edge national security programs focused on international WMD nonproliferation. Successful candidates will interface extensively with US Govt customers and in some cases with foreign government counterparts. Fast paced environment with some positions requiring routine international travel (4-6 trips per year).

Job responsibilities include: 1) Acquisition support (acquisition strategy reviews, development of statements of work (SOW), technical evaluations of proposals, and support for contracting actions); and/or 2) Program management support (requirements determination based on US national security interests, foreign partner country requests and USG Policy; cost- schedule- and performance analysis of work performed by US and foreign implementing contractors; technical and programmatic project reviews overseas to assess work accomplished; development of reports and presentations).
